Aquatic Education Packing List

This is a suggested list of the minimum personal items required for the trip. You may include any additional items you feel appropriate.

Entertainment items such as tape and CD players, DVD players, and video games are allowed as long as they are equipped with headphones. Each item should be clearly marked with the student's name. These items are the full responsibility of the student!

PERSONAL ITEMS

Toothbrush	Sunglasses	Sunscreen (SPF 30 or higher)
Toothpaste	Hairbrush/Comb	Soap & Shampoo
Deodorant	Three Beach towels	Hat/Visor
Pens/Pencils	Insect Repellent	Flashlight w/ Batteries

NOTE: **Light Weight Blanket** - Buildings have AC but typically a blanket is not needed. Beds are provided with top/bottom sheet and pillow w/ case.-Blanket use is at your discretion

Snorkel Equipment-Program includes mask, fins and snorkel – if student has their own equipment, it is encouraged that they bring it, as they are most familiar with their own equipment.-Wet Suite are available, for a nominal fee

CLOTHING

Shorts	Sweat suit/Warm-up suit (for after exiting the water)
Shirts	Jacket (appropriate for the season and after exiting the water)
Pants	Two (2) bathing suits (Ladies-ONE PIECE ONLY)

SPECIAL ITEMS-MUST HAVE!!

~ Aqua Socks or sandals **with straps** suitable for walking in water ("**flip-flop's & Crocks**" are unacceptable-you need something with a sole and straps)

~ Large drinking cup (12-16oz) with tight fitting lid, insulated with a drinking straw is preferred, with name clearly marked on side. These are a must and students will be required to purchase one if they do not bring their own (NOTE: **Disposable drinking cups are not provided to help reduce waste**)

~ Foul Weather Raingear (**Water and wind resistant is preferred-Programs are NOT canceled for rain or inclement weather-Be Prepared!**)
