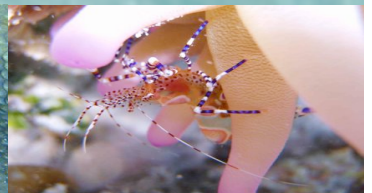


## On the land...

Pigeon Key is a five-acre island surrounded by pristine tropical waters. Originally used as a camp for the Overseas Railroad workers in the early 1900s, it's now kept by The Pigeon Key Foundation, a 501©-3 non-profit, which hosts Scuba clubs, marine education and retreat groups. Meals are included upon request.

The island has many activities to offer during your stay including snorkeling around the island, tide-pooling, a volleyball and basketball court, horseshoes, bocce, fishing, and two-mile bridge walk over the Florida Bay where it is common to see tarpon, eagle rays, sea turtles and many other ocean animals.
